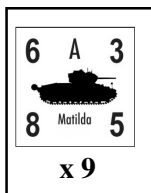

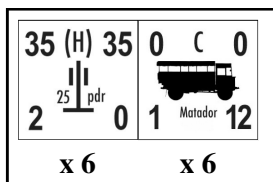

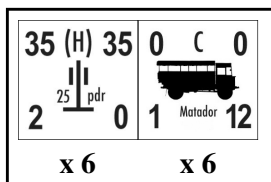

They became the 7th RTR and were attached to the 4th Indian for the start of Operation Compass. After the 4th Indian was withdrawn in January, they were attached to the 6th Australian and were an invaluable part of the operation.

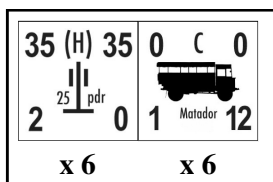
