The 36th Motorized Division entered Russia in 1941 as part of Army Group North, but became part of Army Group Central for the 1942 summer offensives. In mid-1943, the division lost most of its trucks and became just an Infantry Division again. Eventually destroyed on the Russian front, the division was rebuilt in the west as the 36th Volksgrenadier Division and fought the western allies there until the end of the war.
