

The 9th Panzer Division began the campaign in Army Group Center where it helped to capture Kiev along with over 600,000 Russian soldiers. In early 1942, the 9th was sent to Army Group South and was reinforced with a third tank battalion in June in preparation for the German summer offensive in the south called Case Blue. In August, the 9th Panzer was sent back to Army Group Center to help defend the line against another expected Russian winter offensive.
