The 15th Panzergrenadier Division had spent the early part of it life as the 15th Panzer Division, fighting in the Afrika Korps until it was virtually destroyed in May of 1943 in Tunisia. The remnants of the division were rebuilt into a panzergrenadier division and saw much action in Italy. Just prior to the bulge, the 15th PzGr Division had spent November engaged in the heavy fighting for Aachen. Heavy tank losses in its panzer battalion were made up with assault guns for the Ardennes attack and infantry replacements were sent to make up some of the losses as well. The division spent most of the Battle of the Bulge trying unsuccessfully to take Bastogne from the 101st Airborne and supporting units.
