Not released from OKW until December 22, the powerful Fuhrer Grenadier Brigade was still strung out in traffic jams when it was sent to face Patton's counterattack from the south. With only pieces of it in action, the brigade was forced back and a counterattack by the FGB was defeated by American artillery. The brigade was replaced in the line in early January after having had little impact on the battle.
