This corps was ordered to support the main thrust in the south. It was to break through the Russian lines on both sides of Butovo and drive swiftly to the southern bank of the Pena River, while maintaining contact with the II SS Panzer Korps. After reaching the Pena River, XLVIII Panzer Korps was to cover the left flank of II SS Panzer Korps against strong enemy forces presumed to be in the vicinity of Oboyan.
