10th SS Panzer Recon Battalion. Arrived at NE Arnhem on Day 2 and attacked for several days against the perimeter along with other arriving forces.

The 10th SS Panzer Division had been largely destroyed in the battle for Normandy and was only a shell of itself. The shattered division was temporarily renamed KG Frundsberg and sent to Holland for rebuilding, headquartered near Arnhem. Just days before Market-Garden, the 10th was ordered back to Germany for final rebuilding followed by a deployment at Aachen. The airdrop on September 17th changed everything and the KG was deployed in a number of smaller kampfguppen fighting around Arnhem and Nijmegen, with the 10th Pioneers arriving at Nijmegen on Day 2 to wire the bridge for demolition and becoming part of the defending forces there. After the end of Market-Garden, the division did not receive its rebuild until January and was eventually destroyed fighting the Russians outside Berlin.
