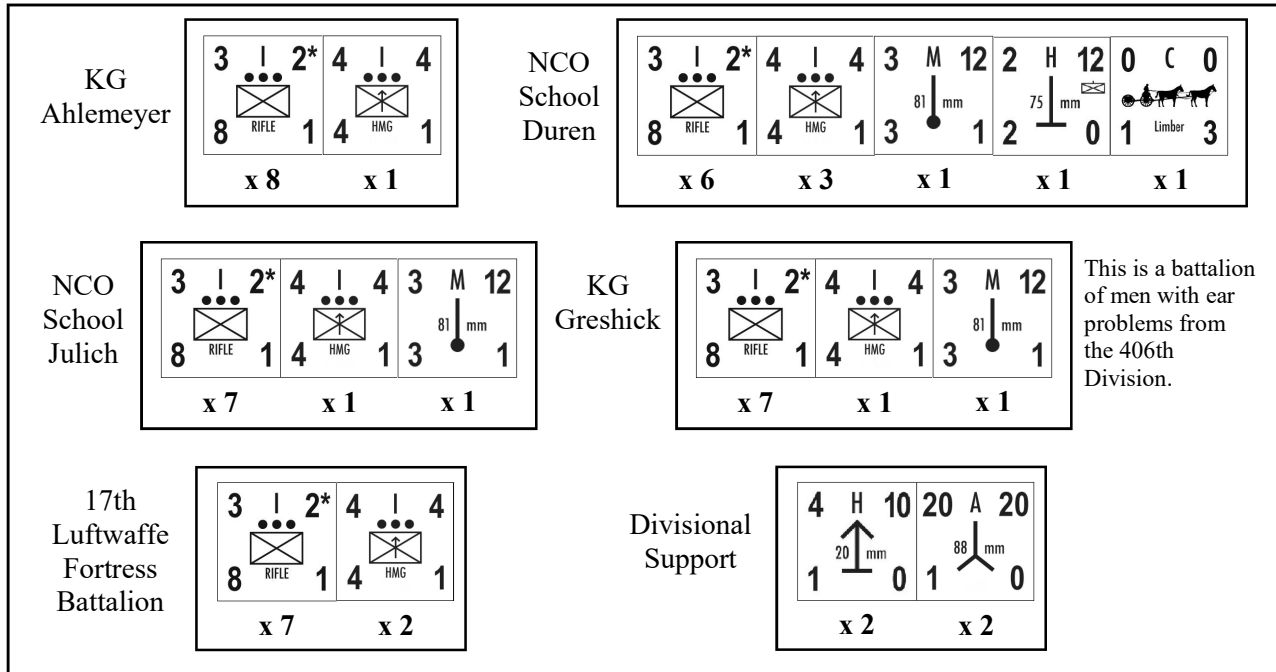


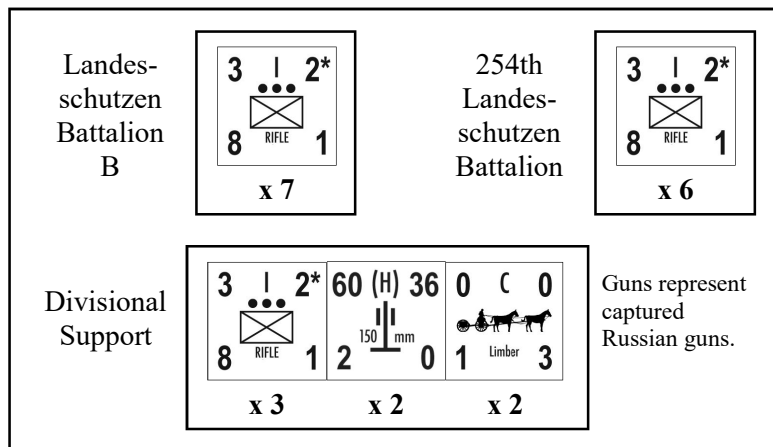
Korps Feldt

Korps Feldt was essentially a mixed bag of rear area and training commands given to General Kurt Feldt to organize a defense of the German border only a couple of miles from Nijmegen. These groups attacked from Germany beginning on Day 1 against the 82nd Airborne defending the heights just east of Groesbeek to the southeast of Nijmegen. These attacks were only the beginning of an often disjointed effort by the Germans to capture the 82nd landing zone and to defend Nijmegen. These constant attacks required the 82nd Airborne to keep half of the division defending the heights throughout the whole operation.
