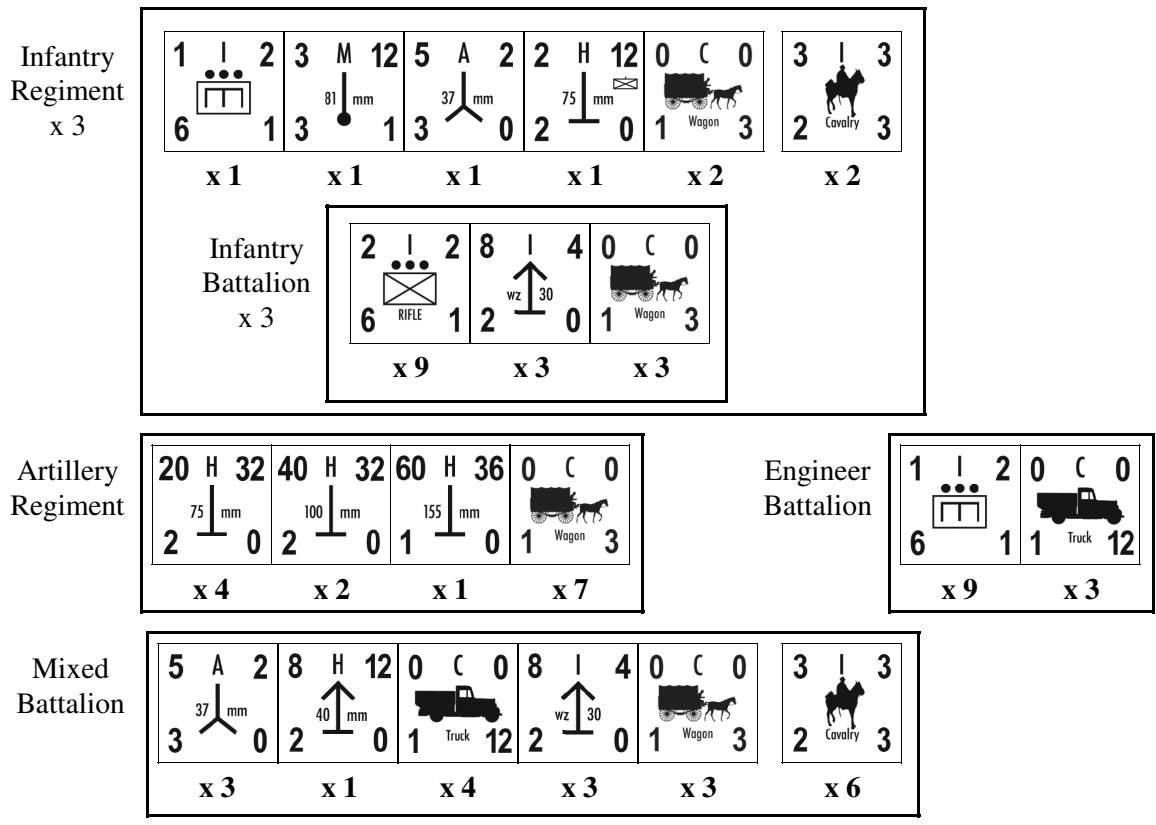


Polish Infantry Division

Consists of 3 infantry regiments of 3 battalions each, 1 artillery regiment, 1 engineer battalion, and 1 mixed battalion.

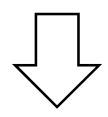

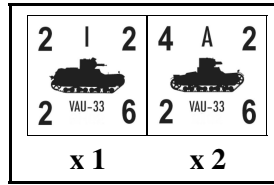
Notes : Many divisions had national defense battalions and tank companies attached to them.

- 4th Infantry : add 1 National Defense Battalion (Type 4)
- 7th Infantry : add 1 National Defense Battalion (Type 4)
- 9th Infantry : add 1 National Defense Battalion (Type 4)
- 10th Infantry : add 2 TK-3 Tank Companies
- 14th Infantry : add 5 National Defense Battalions (Type 4) and 1 TK-3 Tank Company
- 15th Infantry : add 1 National Defense Battalion (Type 4) and 1 National Defense Battalion (Type 2)
- 16th Infantry : add 1 National Defense Battalion (Type 4)
- 17th Infantry : add 1 TK-3 Tank Company
- 18th Infantry : add 1 National Defense Battalion (Type 4)
- 20th Infantry : add 2 National Defense Battalions (Type 4) and 2 TKS Tank Companies
- 25th Infantry : add 3 National Defense Battalions (Type 4) and 1 TKS Tank Company
- 26th Infantry : add 1 National Defense Battalion (Type 4), 1 National Defense Battalion (Type 2), 1 TK-3 Tank Company, and 1 TKS Tank Company
- 30th Infantry : add 2 TK-3 Tank Companies

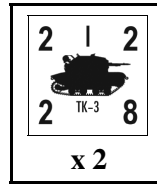

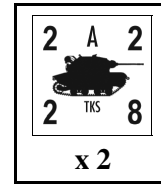

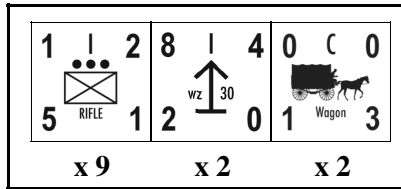
